### BREEDING CONTRACT

I hereby confirm my reservation to the stallion \_\_\_\_\_ (hereafter referred to as "the stallion") standing at Maggie's Menagerie for the 20\_\_\_\_ breeding season for the mare:

I agree to pay Maggie's Menagerie the breeding fee of \_\_\_\_\_ to be paid as a \$250.00 non-refundable booking fee with the balance of \_\_\_\_\_ due at the time the mare arrives on the farm for breeding or before the first semen shipment. The mare will not be covered until these fees are paid.

Additional charges, as applicable, include:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ deposit for shipped semen from which expenses will be taken. There will be no next heat shipments until the semen containers are returned in good condition.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ /day dry mare care.  
\_\_\_\_\_ /day wet mare care.
3. Veterinary expenses deemed necessary by Maggie's Menagerie to further the possibility of pregnancy in my mare or in cases of emergency relating to the mare or any foal at her side. Diligent efforts will be made to contact the mare and/or foal owner prior to obtaining said services.

I understand that the mare will not be released from the premises nor will a breeding certificate be issued until all fees are paid.

I understand that the mare must be accompanied by the following at the time of arrival on the farm:

1. a current negative coggins test;
2. a veterinary health certificate stating that the mare has fulfilled the following requirements;
  - a. been dewormed within 2 weeks prior to arrival on the farm
  - b. is free of all contagious and infectious diseases
  - c. been vaccinated within 12 months for tetanus, eastern and western encephalomyelitis, and rabies and within 6 months for influenza and rhinopneumonitis
  - d. is in sound breeding condition as evidenced by a negative culture and/or cytology taken during the current breeding season while the mare was in heat.

In the case of transported semen, the following criteria must be met:

1. 2.d. above
2. The Mare Breeding Passport and the Delivery Certificate for Transported Semen must be signed and returned to Maggie's Menagerie in order for the terms of this contract to be guaranteed.

In exchange for the above, Maggie's Menagerie agrees to provide care for the mare (and foal) and to make every effort to return the mare in foal. Should the mare fail to conceive and produce a live foal (defined as one that stands and nurses within 24 hours), the mare owner shall have one more season to get that mare or another mare of the mare owner's choice rebred. At the end of the second breeding season, the terms of this contract will have been

fulfilled and the stallion owner will not be obligated to provide further breedings for the original stud fee. In order for this live foal guarantee to be valid, the following criteria must be met:

1. The mare must be pregnancy checked between 40 and 70 days from the last breeding date and Maggie's Menagerie notified of the status of the mare prior to 80 days after the last breeding date.
2. In the event that the mare dies during pregnancy, aborts, or fails to produce a live foal, Maggie's Menagerie must be notified within two weeks of discovery of the event by a letter signed by a licensed veterinarian.
3. In the case where another mare is to be substituted for breeding, the mare owner must supply;
  - a. a certificate from a licensed veterinarian stating that the original mare is not in foal,
  - b. the name, breed, registration number and a copy of the mare's registration papers for the substitute mare prior to breeding the new mare.

Should the stallion die or become unfit for service prior to breeding the mare, then the breeding and booking fees and the semen shipment deposit shall be refunded. Should the stallion die or become unfit for service after the mare has been serviced, then the booking fee shall not be refunded and a prorated portion of the breeding fee shall be refunded according to the following schedule: one half of the breeding fee less booking fee will be refunded after the first breeding season is complete and before the mare is covered for the second season, and no refund will be made thereafter. The breeding fee is not otherwise refundable.

The mare owner or agent agrees not to hold Maggie's Menagerie, its owners, agents or employees liable or responsible for the death, injury, disease or accident of or to the mare or any foal accompanying her and hereby releases them from any and all liability with respect thereto. Maggie's Menagerie, its owners, agents and employees agree to release the mare owner or agent from any liability for the death, injury, disease or accident to the stallion attributable to her stay on the farm.

This contract is executed in duplicate and shall be legally binding on the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
